## 'WILD AND WONDERFUL'



- Orchid – a type of flowering plant, often exotic and delicate.
- Habitat – the natural home or environment of an animal, plant, or other organism.
- Conservation – the protection and preservation of the natural environment.
- Ecology – the branch of biology dealing with the relations of organisms to one another and to their physical surroundings.
- Grubs – insect larvae that feed on plants and can cause damage.
- Cultivate – to prepare and use land for growing plants.
- Biodiversity – the variety of plant and animal life in a particular habitat.
- Pollination – the process by which pollen is transferred to enable fertilisation in plants.
- Sustainability – the ability to maintain ecological balance by avoiding depletion of natural resources.
- Ecosystem – a community of interacting organisms and their environment.
- Botany – the scientific study of plants.
- Environmental impact – the effect that human activities have on the natural world.
- Restoration – the act of returning something to its original condition, often used in environmental contexts.
- Species – a group of living organisms consisting of similar individuals.
- Organic – relating to or derived from living matter; often used to describe natural gardening methods
